readiness" online development system that connects youth and young adults in a way

that helps students identify and tap into their creative talents. Through customized

workshops, conferences and master classes, the program addresses the educational,

developmental, financial, and survival needs of the participants. Students will learn to

connect their passion with purpose driven liberal arts and vocational educational and

practical work experience to create gainful, employment opportunities.

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2Unique's Find Your Design year-round customized program. The Find Your Design Program provides:

- Experiential Learning opportunities for student success through paid and nonpaid training and internships;
- Job Experience for the Future Workforce;
- Guidance and Counseling;
- Paid Internship Opportunities/Employer Partnerships;
- Project Based Leadership activities;
- Mentor participant throughout the internship; Community & Service Learning.

The desired outcomes of our programs include allowing participants to connect with relevant real-life practicum, internship placements, apprenticeships, college preparation or volunteer work experience to enhance their work skills and increase post-graduation employment rates.

Our current services and activities engage students in experiential learning opportunities for student success through paid training, apprenticeships, and internships, provide career experience with an opportunity for continuing formal education, create jobs and cultivate talent through customized programming, guidance and counseling, paid internship opportunities/employer partnerships, project-based leadership activities and community/service-learning projects.

We have direct referral process for GED/HI Set attainment with HOPE Works. We have volunteers to assist with tutoring students through the process. In additional, we have established a potential partnership for an apprenticeship program Lewis Mechanical and Boilermakers and Welding Institute. Boilermakers and Welding Institute proposes to establish and lead advanced manufacturing leaders to provide an innovative apprenticeship program designed to enhance and develop currently employed or

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unemployed low skilled workers as well as novice or new students to the vast world of advanced manufacturing opportunities.

Healthcare Readiness Institute has agreed to assist with providing training opportunities for Healthcare workers such as Certified Nursing Assistants and Dialysis Technicians. Unemployed, underemployed, and incumbent workers oftentimes face many life barriers that prevent them from pursuing a successful pathway to gainful employment. Holistic and wrap around services will be provided through our case management program staff. Building on the tenets of WIOA processing, we will utilize Individual employment plans (IEP). We will customize or Learn Dash database program to be able to compile the identified barriers to employment. Case managers should meet monthly with each program participant to ascertain if revealed barriers are being addressed and corrected. Some supportive services will include job readiness preparation such as clothing or workforce attire and resume preparation and other services such as nutritional assistance.

Participant-level data will be customized to report on the 6 WIOA primary indicators of performance: 1) Employment Rate – Second Quarter After Exit – 1a) Education and Employment Rate – Second Quarter after exit (Young Adults) 2) Education and Employment Rate – Fourth Quarter after Exit 2a) Education and Employment Rate after fourth Quarter after Exit; 3) Median Earning – Second Quarter After exit; 4) Credential Attainment- Credential attainment; 5) Measurable Skills Gains; 6) Effectiveness in Serving Employers.

We have also aligned our program with the Greater Memphis Chamber and Shelby County Workforce Development Nonprofit Committee workforce plans. One of their initiatives is to bring 10,000 people back to the workforce, pairing them with job training programs that can get them into higher-paying positions that are already available and keep training them to evolve as jobs evolve. The Chamber has positioned itself to help

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provide potential leads, employment opportunities and training services that will promote upward mobility for marginalized individuals in our region.

Our other partners include Elocin Consulting LLC and Heal the Hood Foundation of Memphis. They have positioned their organizations to help provide potential job leads, employment opportunities and training services that will promote upward mobility of marginalized individuals in our region.

The Find Your Design program is specifically engineered so that it can be a mobile program. We are poised to provide online training to colleges and school districts in other cities.
